

# The Resina Market

The Market of Resina born around 1944, is perhaps the most famous of the markets of second-hand clothes and military uniform of soldiers of the Second World War, of the entire center-south. It takes place every day among alleys and squares around Via Pugliano, in Ercolano.

After a period of crisis after the earthquake of the '80 when the buildings in Via Pugliano had suffered extensive structural damage, the market was reborn after 1996 thanks to an intense program of rebirth.
